Registration Fees

Early registration is encouraged, as camp fills quickly. Fees are to be paid in full at the time of registration. Families enrolling in multiple sessions may pay in two installments: 50% with the registration and application and 50% by April 30. All payments must be made by April 30th to reserve a space. Payments made after April 30th forfeit a guarantee of your space unless special arrangements have been made with the business office. Payments may be made by check or direct draft only. Please make checks payable to Community Independent School. (CIS)

Late Registration

Enrollment is accepted up to the first day of each session if openings are available. Please contact the school office at 919.932.6313 or info@communityindependentschool.org to check for availability.

Refunds

Registration fees are nonrefundable. CIS will refund 100% of camp tuition fee, provided a cancellation is made in writing three weeks prior to the camp session in which your child is enrolled. CIS will issue a refund, less a \$25 processing fee per session. CIS reserves the right to request a camper not return to camp due to behavioral issues. Should this occur mid-session, remaining camp fees will be forfeited and fees for future sessions will be refunded. Absences due to illness or cancellations mid-session, will result in forfeiture of remaining camp fees for that session.

Late Pick-up Fees

If you are late picking up your child, they will join the other campers in the extended day program and you will be charged a \$10 late fee. After 5:30pm you will be charged an additional \$5/half hour.

Snacks & Lunch

CIS will provide healthy snacks throughout the day for all campers. All campers must bring their own lunch including drinks. Please pack a water bottle for your child. CIS follows a food for fuel policy for our students and campers. Please pack lunches with healthy nutritional food that fuels the body and leave snacks and treats for home.

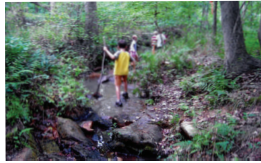
